- Deadline: Completed registration forms are due by 15 August 2016. These can be submitted as an email attachment or sent via mail.
- Registration: Once MBU COE receives your completed form, we will register you for a fall graduate course (3 semester hours).
- Tuition: 2017 Tuition is \$740 for 3 hours graduate credit. Please note: ED626 tuition is ½ the regular MBU Graduate tuition (per our partnership agreement). Tuition payment is due by September 5, 2017.
- Payment: Participating students may send a personal check, school division check or school division invoice (requesting MBU direct billing). If you would rather pay by Visa card, we request that you make the payment immediately upon receipt of your MBU ID number (in the mail)....go onto the MBU website under Campus Life to pay tuition.
- Signatures: Those of you taking the ED626 course will be asked to sign the MBU Honor Code as is standard for most university students these days. You will also sign the Tuition Agreement on the registration form- basically a promise that you will pay your tuition by the deadline on the bill (unless we have already received payment).
- MBU On-Line: You will receive a Mary Baldwin University email address and password in the mail. It is important that you complete the on-line "set-up" ASAP, as you will be completing assignments and communicating via a Blackboard Web-based system. Your email address and password will allow you to use the system. Dr. Willis will provide a training session on Blackboard if needed.
- Course Credit: Upon successful completion of ED626, you will receive 3 hours of graduate credit. The grade will come in the mail and you may request an official transcript to submit for recertification points. Should you decide to take additional courses in the Environment-Based Learning (EBL) program at MBU, the Chesapeake Classrooms course will count toward the 12 credit certificate in EBL or toward the M.Ed. degree in EBL (33 credits).
