

CLEAN THE BAY DAY SAFETY TIPS, VOLUNTEER SIGN-IN & RELEASE

All participants age 18 and older MUST read and sign the following (under 18 need not sign):

- YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for your safety and the safety of children under 18 you directly supervise. An adult must accompany and directly supervise children under 18 OR provide a completed Parental Permission Form to the Zone Captain.
- NOTIFY ZONE CAPTAIN of accidents, unsafe behavior, hazardous materials and other concerns.
- WEAR closed toe shoes, long-sleeved shirts, hats, gloves. Use sunscreen, bug spray and safety vests if near roads.
- AVOID hazardous items -- oil containers, drums, medical waste, chemicals, explosives, etc. Use trowel to pick up broken glass or other sharp objects and store sharps in a solid container.
- AVOID bees, wasps, snakes and similar animals. Notify the Zone Captain of bee sting or similar allergies. Bring any needed medicine.
- USE COMMON SENSE. Take breaks. Drink plenty of fluids. Do not overfill bags.
- BOATERS AND DIVERS – Observe all safety precautions. Boaters must always wear life preservers. Divers must be SCUBA-certified by a recognized organization (e.g., PADI, NAUI, YMCA).

I have read the above Safety Tips. I understand that participation in Clean the Bay Day is entirely voluntary. I understand the risks involved in the “hands on” activities of Clean the Bay Day. I understand that any medical expenses will be billed directly to my insurance company or me. I hereby grant to The Chesapeake Bay Foundation, Inc. the right to photograph or videotape me and/or my property and to use these videotapes and photographs in its discretion.
