SUMMARY OF NEED: Chesapeake Bay Foundation's Urban Restoration Program requires approximately 15,500 wetland plants used in a living shoreline project in Hampton, Virginia.

THE PROJECT: CBF is installing a living shoreline and grass/perennial buffer along the banks of the Hampton River, adjacent to the Mallard Point Condominium complex at Eberly Terrace, Hampton, VA 23669. The project will add 3,312.75 square feet (sf) of oyster habitat, add/enhance 15,946 sf of low marsh and high marsh habitat, and convert 15,774 sf of turf grass to a native vegetated buffer.
